Attention Students!

Eligibility & Awards Available

Each applicant must be a full time undergraduate or graduate student in water resources related degree program. Students must be enrolled in a program relating to water resources for the 2019-2020 academic year.

\$2500 Scholarship

The MSSC will contribute \$2,500 in value to the student/professor selected.

\$1200 Cash Award to Student Scholarship Winner

2020 Summit Value:

2 nights lodging for winning student & professor (Tuscany) (\$300)

Complimentary registration for winning student & professor (500)

Travel allowance for winning student & professor (\$250 each)

Selection Criteria

The scholarship will be awarded to the student based on the overall evaluation of a 500-word essay about career objectives, transcript, letter of recommendation, and leadership in extracurricular activities related to water resources.

Application Process

A complete application packet contains:

- Application title page that includes the applicant's full name, permanent mailing address, email address, phone number where he or she may be easily reached, and the type of scholarship (undergraduate or graduate). (1 page)
- Two-page summary (approx. 500 words) of his/her academic interests and achievements, extracurricular interests, and career goals as they relate to their field of study.
- Resume (1 page)
- One signed letter of reference from professor and/or advisor. Letter of reference **MUST** include the signatures of the professor. (1 page)
- Transcripts of all college courses (undergraduate and graduate). Legible copies of "Issued to Student" transcripts are acceptable. Documents must establish he/she is currently active in higher education or in an internship in water resources or related fields.

Submittal Information

The entire application shall be limited to ten (10) pages (front only, no double sided). Application packets should be submitted electronically to MSSC. **All applications must be submitted in their entirety.** MSSC **will** provide an acknowledgement of receipt of your application but **will not** provide updates to your application status or request missing information. Please make sure your application is complete when it is submitted. We look forward to hearing from you.

* The MSSC Board of Directors may, at its sole discretion, approve additional scholarship awards, based upon availability of funds.

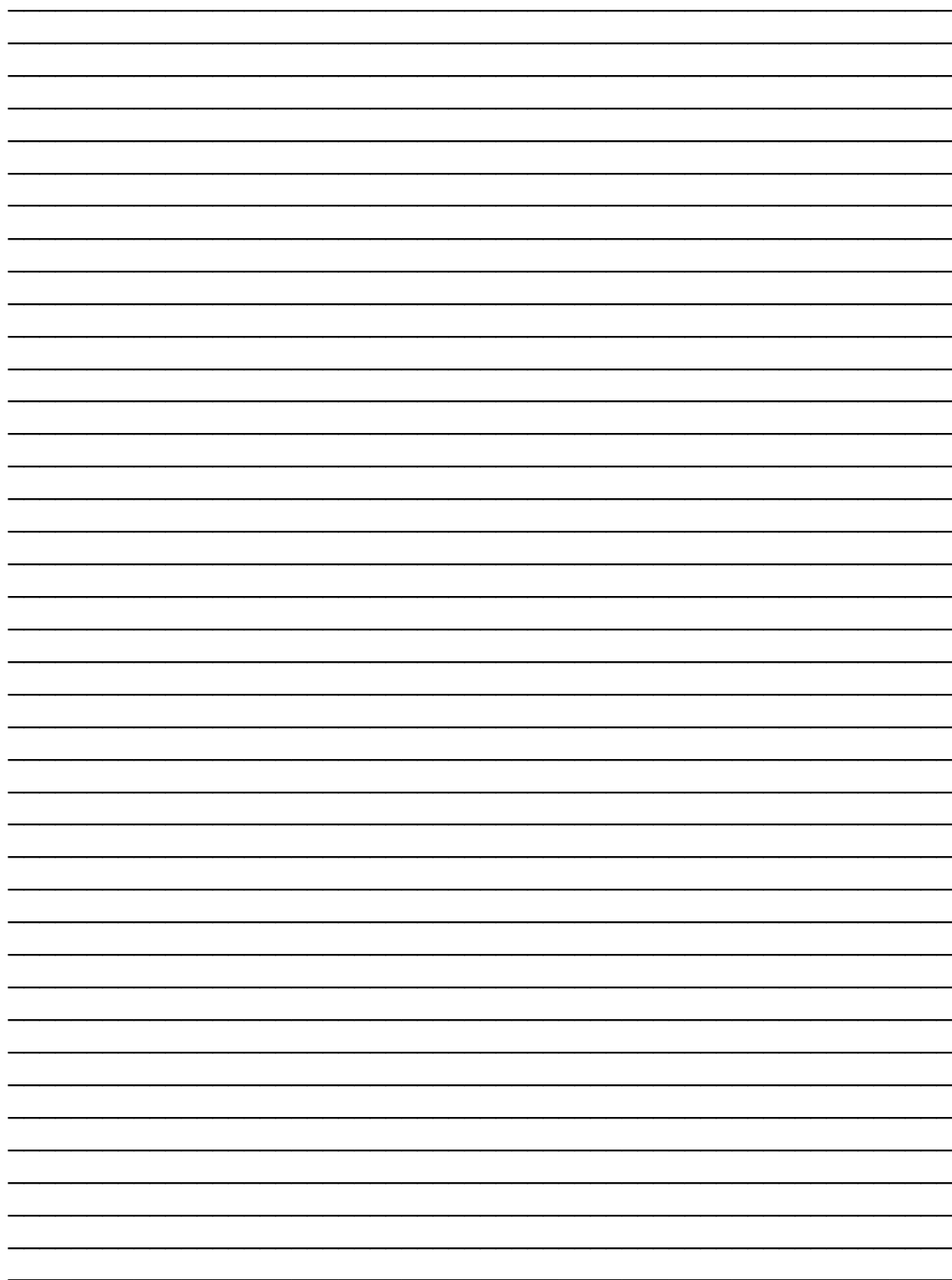

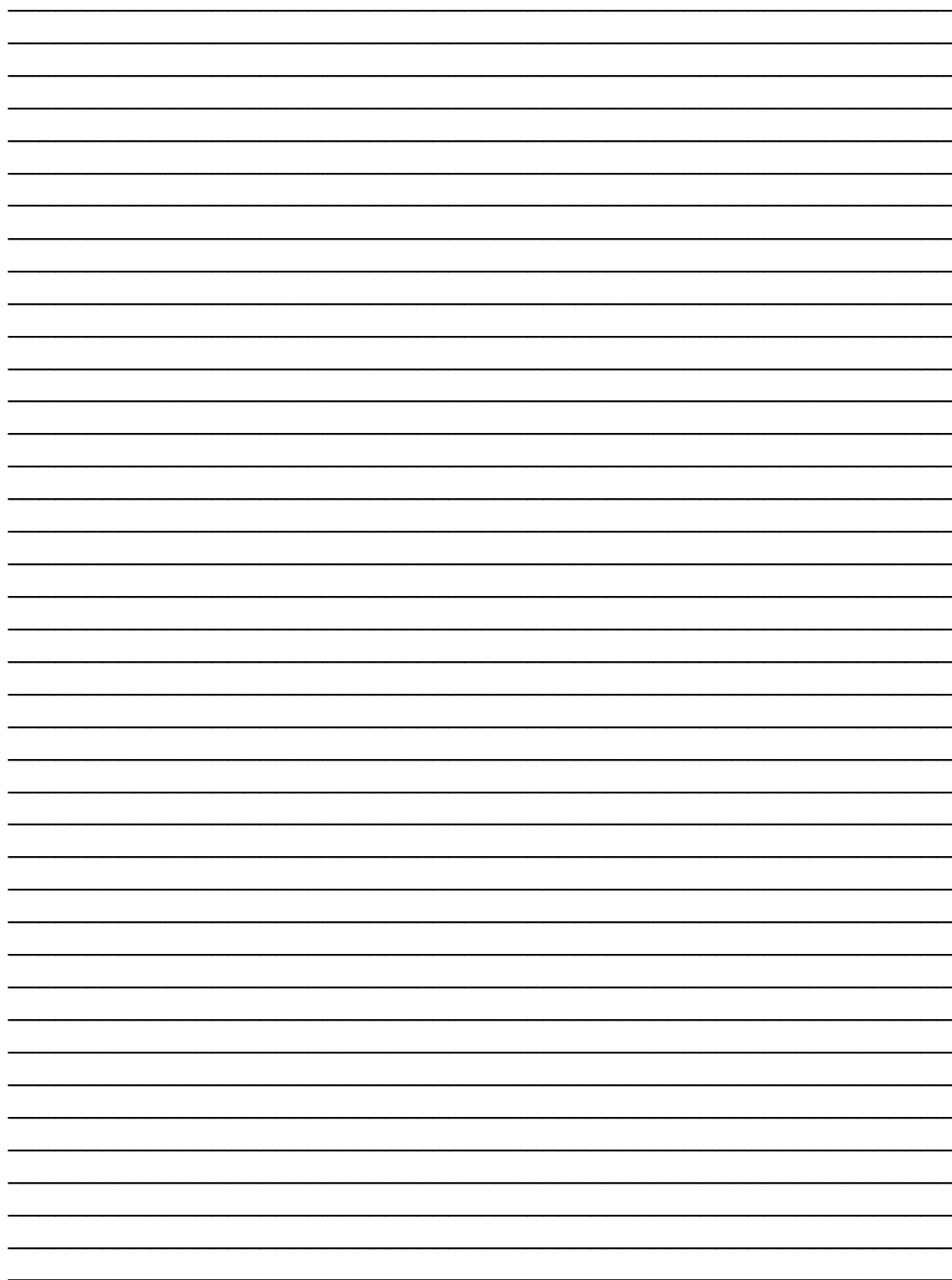
