









# Historic Decisions provide Resilient Water Supplies






- 1948: Gates on Horseshoe Dam
- 1984: Plan approved to raise Roosevelt Dam
- 1985: Use of Colorado River Water while easing off wells
- 1995: Three-way exchange with reclaimed water
- Water Wheeling and Storage Agreements
- Regional Projects and Partnerships
